Number of Calls

4,318 calls (4,095 calls in 2021) Average of 341 calls per month/11.8 calls per day (5% increase over 21 & 18% increase over 20)

2,744 transports/average of 7.5 per day Patient transported to the hospital on 66.4% of calls (2,722/66.4% in 2021) This is a 1% increase over 2021

Volunteer Commitment

More than 15,000 Scheduled and Documented Volunteer Responder Hours during 2022

Includes actual scheduled hours, unscheduled responses to additional calls, and management/leadership time.

1,410 calls were answered by 55 volunteer EMTs, AEMTs, and Paramedics (1,429/57 in 21) *Volunteers participated in 33% of calls*

12% increase in the number of calls handled by volunteers in the last five years (1,258 in 2017)

- 10 Volunteers Were on Call for More Than 400 Hours During 2022
- 16 Volunteers Were on Call for More Than 200 Hours During 2022
