





## College Student Bunk-in Program at

## **Delmar-Bethlehem EMS (DBEMS)**

Rent Free Housing and a Unique College Experience for EMTs

The Delmar-Bethlehem EMS bunk-in program provides rent free housing to qualifying college students in exchange for being an active and responding ambulance crew member. The program is available to college students living in the Capital region who are EMT certified and ready for duty.

Applicants are being sought for the semester beginning January 1, 2026 and the academic year beginning in the Fall of 2026.

## **Applicants must:**

- Be 19 years of age at the start of the program
- Be a NYS certified EMT and maintain certification
- Attend an area college/university full-time or the HVCC or Cobleskill Paramedic program
- Maintain school enrollment throughout the length of bunk-in participation
- Ride 18 scheduled hours per week on an ambulance crew (3 six-hour shifts/week)
- Meet the requirements for DBEMS membership, have EMT experience with an ambulance service, and be able to quickly assume duty as an ambulance "Crew Chief"
- Meet DBEMS driver requirements and have CEVO or EVOC training
- Commit for the spring 2026 semester and/or the full 2026-2027 academic year; can be expanded to include summers

Bunk-In Program participants will live in a recently renovated two-bedroom furnished apartment that will be shared with another Bunk-In EMT. The apartment is located one mile from the EMS Station. On-duty time will be spent in our EMS stations with recently upgraded crew day rooms, kitchens, study areas, and private bunk rooms. Bunk-in shifts are between 6 pm and 6 am. Average call volume on the 12-hour evening/night shift is a total of 4 calls, split between two on-duty ambulance crews. Duty uniforms and equipment will be provided. The apartments are 8 miles from the University at Albany, 10 miles from HVCC and 49 miles from SUNY Cobleskill.
